



## COVER ROCK-IT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Lay-out and verify that all parts are present according to the Cover Rock-It Parts and Hardware Charts.

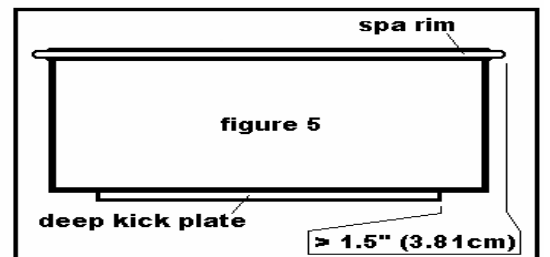
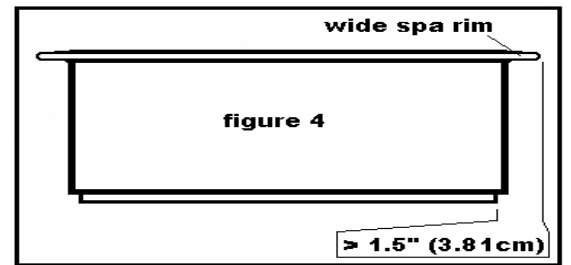
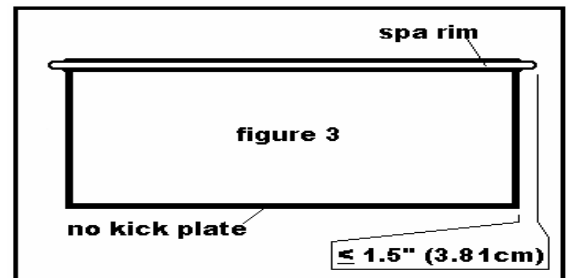
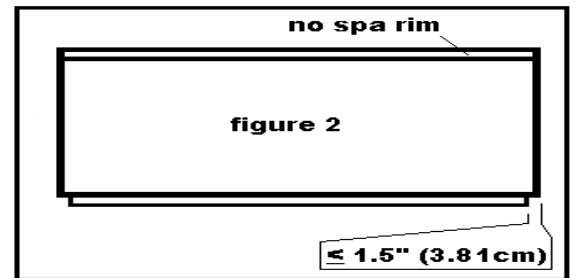
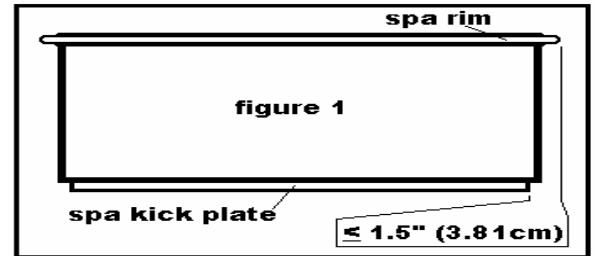
2. Determine which example of spa rim and cabinet combination best matches the spa you have.
3. Figures 1 & 2 show the best examples for mounting the T-Bracket (crEE) to the sides of the spa's kick plate. The kick plate rests 1.5 inches (3.81cm) or less from the spa shell edge.
4. Figure 3 shows the best examples for using the Under-mount Brackets (crFF – special order part), **or** for mounting the T-Bracket (crEE) through the sides of the spa cabinet and into the spa's internal, structural support beams. (or added external support beam)
5. Figure 4 & 5 show the best examples for mounting the T-Bracket (crEE) through the sides of the spa cabinet and into the spa's internal structural support beams. (or added external support beam).
6. Figure 6 shows an external support beam added to help support the spa cabinet.
7. Slide the T-Brackets (crEE) into the Pivot Elbows (crDD).

8. **Align so that all 3 apply:**

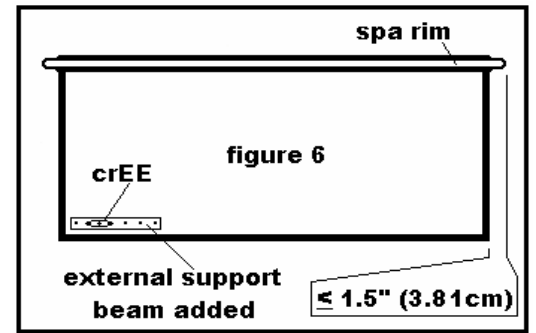
- A. The T-Brackets (crEE) sit as low as possible and flush against the support beam that it is being mounted to. (spa cabinet, beam, kick-plate, etc.).
- B. The Pivot Elbow (crDD) rests on the ground and the arm going up is 6" (15.24cm) away at the base, from the rear of the spa cabinet.
- C. The T-Brackets (crEE) are mounted in the same exact location on opposite sides of the cabinet.

**Measure carefully for both height & depth. Even placement of the T-Brackets (crEE) is critical for optimal function of the Cover Rock-It.**

9. Mark the holes, pre-drill, and mount the T-Brackets (crEE) to the spa using the Lag Screws (crD).
10. Attach the Pivot Elbows (crDD) to the T-Brackets (crEE) using a Washer (crB) and Phillips Bolt (crC) on each side.



11. Slide the Fluted Middle Tube (crAA) into the Regular Middle Tube (crBB) and attach using 3 Self Tapping Screws (crA).
12. Center the spa cover on the spa.
13. Slide the Extension Elbows (crCC) into the Pivot Elbows (crDD) and rock the Pivot Elbows (crDD) forward. Glide the Extension Elbows (crCC) out until it rests on the spa cover just shy of the center seam and hold in place.
14. Attach the Extension Elbows (crDD) to the Pivot Elbows (crCC) using 3 Self Tapping Screws (crA) on each side. (2 in the front 1 in the back).
15. Slide the attached middle tubes into the Extension Elbows (crCC), center, and attach using 3 Self Tapping Screws (crA) on each side.



## COVER ROCK-IT MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

The Cover Rock-it was designed for a specific use. The Cover Rock-It is not designed to BEND, WARP, or to be ABUSE PROOF. **Do not stand, sit, or lie on, or permit heavyweight to rest on the Cover Rock-It.** Do not clean with abrasives, solvents, or strong detergents. Most of the hardware has been Zinc coated for durability, but will deteriorate quicker when exposed to high levels of Chlorine, Bromine, Ozone, or other active chemicals. Check nuts and bolts often and tighten if necessary. Any parts showing evidence of wear should be replaced immediately.

Caution must be used when operating the Cover Rock-It in order to maintain its function and longevity. The maintenance and use instructions are provided to prevent damage to the Cover Rock-It. Damage caused by the failure to follow the maintenance and use instructions will not be covered by the manufacturer's warranty



## COVER ROCK-IT USE INSTRUCTIONS

How to **CLOSE** your spa cover using the Cover Rock-It:

- A. With the spa cover in the upright position, gently guide the Cover Rock-It and spa cover up onto the spa.
- B. Unfold the spa cover, center the cover over the spa, and engage the cover locks if available.

How to **OPEN** your spa cover using the Cover Rock-It:

- A. Gently flip the spa cover over onto itself and the Cover Rock-It.
- B. Lift up spa cover and Cover Rock-It and guide them back behind the spa slowly until the cover is resting by itself in the upright position.



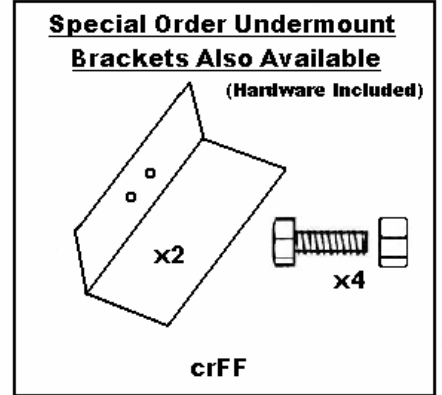
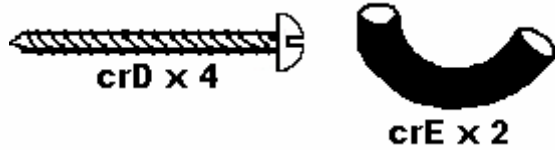

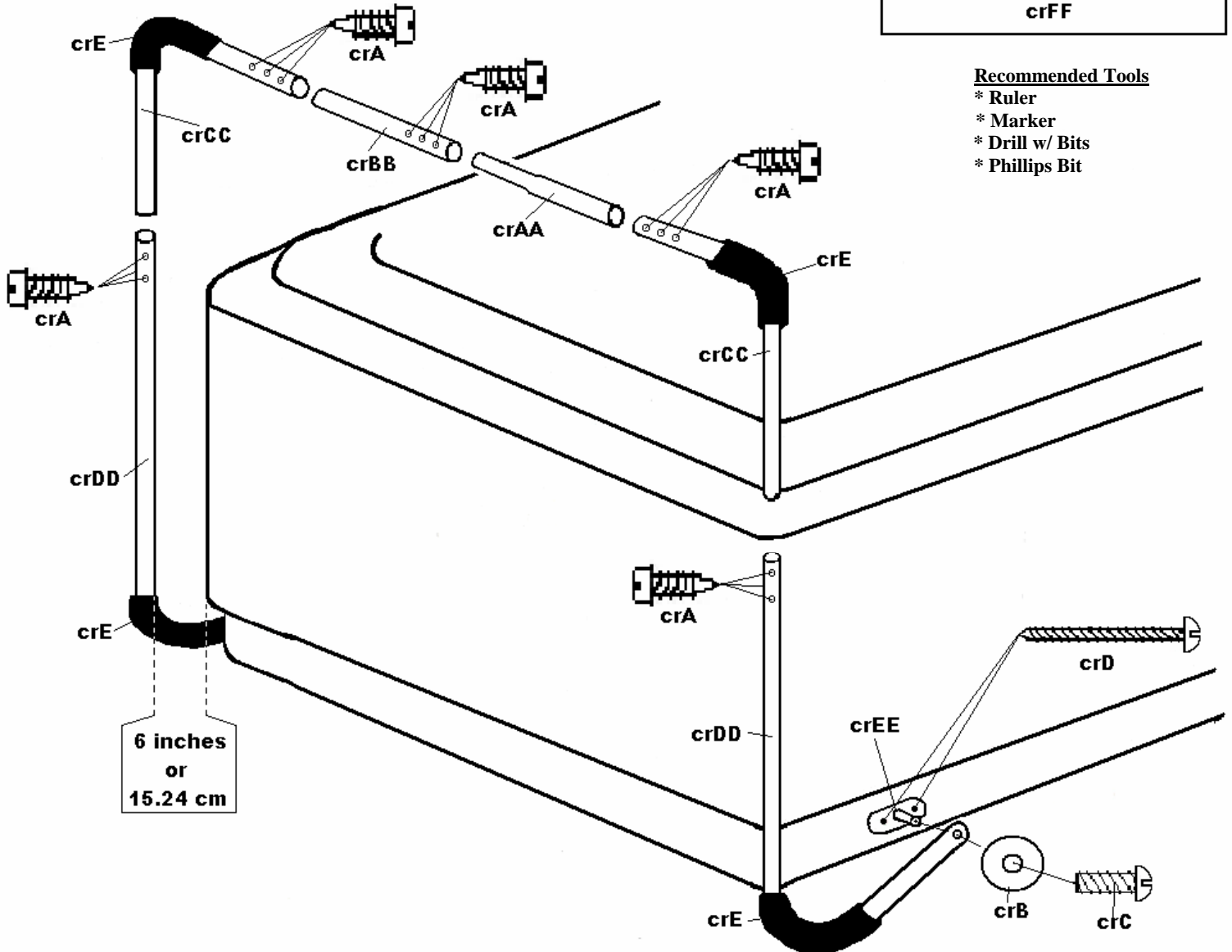
